Information For Students on Key Dates for Jan 2025 intake

- 1. All N(A)*/N(T) school leavers are encouraged to submit an application during the 1st Phase (Main Phase) between 16 Dec 2024 (2.30pm) to 19 Dec 2024 (5pm). Application results for the 1st Phase will be released on 30 Dec 2024 at 9am.
- 2. If you wish to appeal, please accept the course offered <u>before</u> applying in the **2nd** Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase) between <u>30 Dec 2024 to 3 Jan 2025</u>. The application results for the 2nd Phase will be known on <u>10 Jan 2025 at 9am</u>.
- 3. Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the 3rd Phase (Final Top-up Phase) between 10 Jan to 17 Jan 2025 and 23 Jan to 7 Feb 2025 for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3rd Phase will be known between 14 Jan to 23 Jan 2025 and 23 Jan to 13 Feb 2025.

Key Pointers for Students on ITE's Joint Intake Exercise(JIE)

ALL students in N(T) and N(A) students (who are not progressing to 5N(A) or repeating 4N(A)) are eligible for

Those who were unsuccessful in EAE are also eligible for JIE.

Participation in JIE Main Phase is key to securing a place in

Use all 12 JIE choices wisely, as competition for 3-year Higher Nitec courses is keen!

Do consult your teachers / ECG counsellors to help you make your choices!

Do use the Last Aggregate Score (LAS) published in ITE's admission portal to help you make your course choices. If you have received an additional letter, then you are eligible for the Enhanced Foundation Programme (EFP).

If you are eligible for EFP, make sure you apply for both the EFP and the 2-year Nitec/3-year Higher Nitec!

The EFP helps to build the necessary literacy and numeracy foundations that will enable you to successfully complete your course!

If you are counter-offered a course, accept it first before appealing for another course you may be more interested in!

- 3. Click 'Self-Service' followed by 'Student Admission' followed by 'View Application Results' to view the application results and to accept course offer.

JIE 'H' EXERCISE



• The Joint Intake Exercise 'H' (JIE 'H') caters to the direct entry of eligible GCE N(A) holders into full-time 2-year Higher Nitec courses, under the Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP).

Applications for the DPP can be submitted online via the ITE application portal (<u>www.ite.edu.sg</u>) between 2.30 pm on 16
 December 2024 and 5.00 pm on 19 December 2024.

Release of DPP Posting Results and Acceptance of DPP Offers

2-Year Higher Nitec Courses

- The DPP posting results will be released at 2.00pm on Friday, 20
 December 2024. Candidates may check the posting results online via the ITE application portal.
- Students who receive a DPP offer should log on to the ITE application portal between Friday, 20 December 2024 and Thursday, 26 December 2024 to accept or reject the DPP offer.
- You are encouraged to apply for JIE 'N' Exercise too.
- Students who do not have a confirmed place in the DPP should report to their secondary schools in 2024 for Secondary 5.

POLYTECHNIC FOUNDATION PROGRAMME

(PFP)



Application for the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

 Applications for the PFP will open in January 2025, on the day of the GCE Ordinary-Level (O-Level) Examinations results release.
 Candidates eligible for the PFP will receive a copy of Form P on the same day, inviting them to apply for the PFP.



For students who are only interested in the PFP

- You should first progress to Sec 5N(A), even if you meet the PFP eligibility criteria based on their GCE N(A)-Level results.
- You may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2025. If your application is successful, you will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by the end of January 2025.
- All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till the last Friday of January 2025, i.e. **31 January 2025**.

For students who are only interested in the <u>DPP</u>

- You should apply for the **DPP**.
- Students who have **accepted their DPP offers** in December should **not** continue with Sec 5N(A). Please inform the school **General Office and 4NA CCs** so that we need not reserve a place for you in Sec 5 in 2025.

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For students who are interested in applying for both PFP and DPP

- You are encouraged to consider carefully your interests and strengths, as well as the courses offered under both programmes.
- If you are certain that you do not want to continue with Sec 5 and pursue the GCE O-Level, you SHOULD apply for the DPP in December. Upon the release of the GCE O-Level results in January, eligible students may apply for the PFP. If you are offered and accept a PFP place, you can then withdraw from the DPP.

<u>Alternatively</u>

 You may progress to Sec 5 first. Upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January, you may then apply for the PFP and DPP concurrently.



For students who are interested in applying for <u>Sec 5</u>

Sec 4N(A) students can be promoted to Sec 5N(A) if they satisfy **all** the following criteria:-

- (a) Sat for the GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2024;
- (a) Obtained an **ELMAB3** (EL, Mathematics (MA) and best three other subjects) aggregate score of **19 points or less**; and
- (b) Obtained at least an N(A)-Level Grade 5 for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3.

*Subjects graded 'U' in the GCE N(A)-Level cannot be considered for the computation of the ELMAB3 aggregate score.

PROGRESSION TO SEC 4 NORMAL (ACADEMIC)



Pathway for 4NT

Progression from Sec 4N(T) to Sec 4N(A)

If you have achieved Grade A for **both** English Language (EL) and Mathematics (MA), and Grade B or better for **one** other subject at the N(T)-level in one sitting, you can be laterally transferred to Sec 4N(A).


Administrative Instructions

INSTRUCTIONS

You should receive the following from your CCs:

- Result Slip
- Examination Certificate
- Form N (4NA and 4NT)
- CCA Certificate
- Testimonial (Draft)
- **2025 ITE Admission Brochure**

You should acknowledge on the class list the receipt of items 1-5.



Amendment Process - CCA Certificates

Actions to take for any amendment to the CCA Certificate:

- STILL <u>acknowledge the RECEIPT</u>
- Clearly <u>indicate the error</u> and bring the <u>edited copy</u> to the <u>General Office</u> after release of results (4.00 pm onwards)
- GO staff will attend to you
- Ask for a <u>duplicate copy / copies</u> to facilitate your applications before you leave the GO



Amendment Process - N Level Certificates

Candidates may request for a re-print of their certificate only if their name has been printed wrongly due to misspelling. Other reasons for re-printing of certificates will not be accepted.

There is an administrative fee of **\$\$50.00** (inclusive of GST) for the amendment of each GCE N-Level certificate.

Please indicate the error and bring the edited copy to the General Office after the release of results (4.00 pm onwards) and GO staff will attend to you.

Appeal for Review of Results

- Candidates of 2024 GCE N(A)/N(T)-Level examination may apply to appeal for a review of results.
- All appeals by candidates must be submitted through schools.
- Candidates can request for an 'Individual Appeal'. This comprises a review of the marking and a full clerical re-check.
- The candidate will be informed of the outcome via a letter.
- No report on the candidate's performance will be provided.
- The closing date for submission of appeals, including payment of appeal fees is by **20 December 2024.** The payment for an individual appeal is **\$114.45**.
- Applications submitted after the closing date will not be considered.
