CCA Trials and Auditions



Attending Physical Sports (PS)/Visual Performing Arts (VPA) Trials/Auditions are important as there are limited vacancy in each CCA due to resource availability.

Students are required to attend all the trials/auditions, that they intend to indicate as their 5 choices. In allocating the CCA, student who attends the CCA trial/audition shall be prioritised over those.

Students who demonstrated potential will be formally issued with a letter to encourage the student/parent to select this CCA as their top choice.

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CCA Allocation & Appeal



- Based on choice, vacancy, resources & aptitude/talent (Trials / Auditions selection)
- CCA allocation results to be released on <u>31 Jan (Wed)</u>, with CCA training commencing on <u>2 Feb (Fri)</u>
- Students must attend the CCA training that they has been allocated.
- They can seek to appeal to another CCA (with existing vacancy) on $\underline{1}$
