# Strategic Partnership CCA (SP-CCA)

- MOE has partnered SportSG and National Arts Council (NAC) to implement a **centralised, non-school-based** CCA, Strategic Partnership Co-Curricular Activity (SP-CCA) which Secondary students can participate in to pursue their interest in sports
- Students can participate SP-CCA **in-lieu** of School-based CCA
- **Endorsement required** by school



# Strategic Partnership CCA (SP-CCA)

- Students are travel to the respective training venues on their own (e.g. Kallang Practice Track, Bukit Gombak Stadium, Evans Pool)
- **Training details:**
  - **Tuesday** or Thursday, 4 – 6 pm
  - **Saturday**, 8.30 am – 10.30 am (HOA & Evans) / 9.30 am – 11.30am (Bukit Gombak Stadium)

(Students are required to attend 2 sessions per week, 1 weekday and Saturday)

**Compulsory to attend all the CCA trial/audition of student's choices.**

**Note:**

- Attend the trials/audition in PE attire
- Students are to report punctually at the venue for their trials/auditions.
- Available slots are based on first-come-first served basis.
- Student will be dismissed from school after they attending all 5 of the CCAs of choices (which they will submit online)



# CCA Trials and Auditions

- Attending Physical Sports (PS)/Visual Performing Arts (VPA) Trials/Auditions are important as there are **limited vacancy** in each CCA due to resource availability.
- Students **are required to attend all the trials/auditions**, that they intend to indicate as their 5 choices. In allocating the CCA, student who attends the CCA trial/audition shall be prioritised over those.
- Students who demonstrated potential will be formally issued with a **letter** to encourage the student/parent to select this CCA as their top choice.

  - ▷ E.g. 2, Modern Dance (1<sup>st</sup>), Guzheng, AKG, GG, Floorball (5<sup>th</sup>)

# CCA Allocation & Appeal

- Based on choice, vacancy, resources & aptitude/talent (Trials / Auditions selection)
- CCA allocation results to be released on 31 Jan (Wed), with CCA training commencing on 2 Feb (Fri)
- Students must attend the CCA training that they has been allocated. They can seek to appeal to another CCA (with existing vacancy) on 1 Mar (Fri).

Warning ⇒ Detention ⇒ School Suspension  
(Internal & External)

- CCA teacher will contact parents if the child is absent from CCA
- Absence from CCA must be accompanied by Medical Certification from a doctor
- CCA Attendance is included in the computation of Conduct Grade

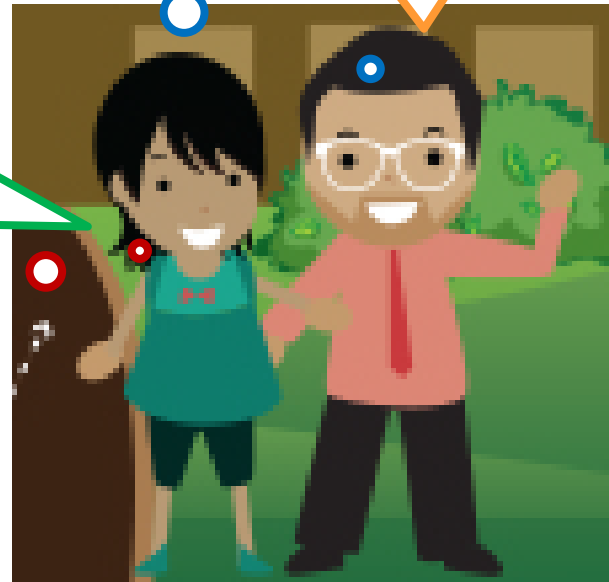
