Dear Parent/Guardian,

Term 2 Week 10 Curriculum Programme for Sec 4 and 5**Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Intensive Programme**

In anticipation of the upcoming National Mother Tongue Language Examinations in May and at the end of the year 2024, Secondary 4 and 5 students enrolled in Express Chinese Language, Malay Language, Chinese B and Higher Chinese Language, will undergo an Intensive Mother Tongue Language Programme on 20 May, 21 May, and 23 May. The programme is designed to enhance students' level of preparedness for their respective examinations.

Students who are not taking MTL can do Home-based Learning and self-study at home in the morning. However, students having coursework in the afternoon must report to school by 1.00 pm.

Coursework

Separately, students doing Coursework Subjects (D&T, NFS, Art) will be required to stay back to continue working on their various coursework components, from 1.00 pm to 5.30 pm, in their respective coursework venues.

Sec 4 Normal (Academic) Schedule

During this period, the timetable for Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) students will be adjusted. These adjustments will allow Secondary 4 Normal (Academic) students to continue their curriculum smoothly, with minimal disruption to their learning progress.
