More Institute of Technical Education (ITE) students will be given the chance to move on to polytechnics from academic year 2027, as part of efforts to expand pathways and choices for students.

Those pursuing a Higher Nitec qualification at ITE will be **guaranteed admission to a polytechnic course related to their Higher Nitec course,** if they attain a grade point average (GPA) of **3.5 or above.**

3-year Higher Nitec at ITE

For Sec 4NA and NT students

- 3-year Higher NITEC offers a streamlined curriculum and students gain exposure to modules in their sector in year 1 before specializing later. Includes 2 internships (Yr 2 & 3)
- Gradual transition from 2-year NITEC to 3-year Higher NITEC courses. From AY2026, all courses will be 3-year Higher NITEC courses.
- Aggregate score is computed based on 4 subjects, including pre-requisite subjects and bonus points. Minimum Entry requirements of the courses differ. Some examples:
 - 3 GCE 'N' Passes in English, Mathematics and 1 other subject
 - 3 GCE 'N' Passes in Mathematics or Science* and 2 other subjects
 - 3 GCE 'N' Passes in English and 2 other subjects
 - 3 GCE 'N' Passes in Mathematics and 2 other subjects
 - Completed N-level
- After graduating from Higher Nitec, ITE graduates can enjoy the ITE progression Award when they pursue diploma:
 - Top-up of \$5000 to Post-Secondary Education Account upon enrolment into Poly course
 - Top-up of \$10,000 to CPF OA upon completion of Poly course

What is EAE?



- For students who have **strong aptitude and interest** in specific fields of study.
 - Students who have applied will be assessed through different modes e.g. Interviews.
- These will take place before their national examinations.
- The students who were successful in their EAE application will still need to meet the two criteria.
 - Criteria: 1. Min. Entry Requirements (MERs)
 - 2. Subject pre-requisites.







Secure a place in a competitive ITE course.

- Just make sure N level results meet the minimum entry
 - requirements (MERs) for the course.

What are MERs?

Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs)

Some possible examples:

- 3 GCE 'N' Passes in English, Mathematics and 1 other subject
- 3 GCE 'N' Passes in Mathematics <u>or</u> Science* and 2 other subjects
- **3 GCE 'N' Passes** in **English** and 2 other subjects
- 3 GCE 'N' Passes in Mathematics and 2 other subjects
- Completed N-level

GCE 'N' Pass refers to Grade A-D (NT) or Grade 1-5 (NA).

*<u>Mobile Robotics, Smart Electrical Technology, IoT Applications, Mechanical Design &</u> <u>Automation</u>, and <u>Mobile Web Applications</u> subjects can be used **in lieu of Science** for admission to these courses.
