

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


- All N(A)\*/N(T) school leavers are encouraged to put in an application during the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase (Main Phase) between <u>18 Dec 2023 (2.30pm) to 21 Dec 2023 (5pm)</u>. Application results for the 1<sup>st</sup> Phase will be released on <u>29 Dec 2023 at 9am</u>.
- If you wish to appeal, please <u>accept the course offered before</u> applying in the 2<sup>nd</sup>
   Phase (Late Application/Appeal Phase) between <u>29 Dec 2023 to 3 Jan 2024</u>. The application results for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase will be known on <u>10 Jan 2024 at 9am</u>.
- Unsuccessful applicants can appeal under the 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase (Final Top-up Phase) between <u>10 Jan to 18 Jan 2024 and 24 Jan to 7 Feb 2024</u> for courses with vacancies. The application results for the 3rd Phase will be known between <u>15 Jan to 24 Jan to 24 Jan to 24 Jan to 14 Feb 2024</u>.



# Application for the Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)

- The Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP) prepares candidates for progression into selected polytechnic diploma courses via a two-year *Higher Nitec* course at ITE. Under the DPP, candidates who successfully complete their *Higher Nitec* course and attain the required minimum qualifying *Higher Nitec* Grade Point Average are guaranteed a place in a polytechnic diploma course mapped to their *Higher Nitec* course. School candidates eligible for the DPP will receive a copy of Form N from their secondary schools, inviting them to apply for the DPP.
- Applications for the DPP can be submitted online via the ITE application portal between 2.30 pm on 18 December 2023 and 5.00 pm on 21 December 2023.

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# Release of ITE Posting Results and Acceptance of ITE Offers

- The ITE posting results will be released at **9.00am** on **Friday, 29 December 2023**. Candidates may check the posting results online via the ITE application portal.
- Candidates who receive an ITE offer should log on to the ITE application portal between 9.00am on Friday, 29 December 2023 and 11.59pm on Wednesday, 3 January 2024 to accept or reject the offer.



# Release of DPP Posting Results and Acceptance of DPP Offers

- The DPP posting results will be released **at 2.00pm on Friday, 22 December 2023**. Candidates may check the posting results online via the ITE application portal.
- Candidates who receive a DPP offer should log on to the ITE application portal between 2.00pm on Friday, 22 December 2023 and 11.59pm on Wednesday, 27 December 2023 to accept or reject the DPP offer.
- School candidates who do not have a confirmed place in the DPP should report to their secondary schools in 2024 for Secondary 5



## **Application for the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)**

- The Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP) is a diploma-specific foundation programme conducted over two academic semesters at the polytechnics. It caters to candidates in the N(A) course who have decided to pursue a polytechnic education and meet the PFP eligibility requirements at the end of Secondary 4.
- School candidates interested in applying for the PFP should first report to their secondary schools in 2024 to start their Secondary 5 year, while awaiting notification of eligibility and confirmation of a place in the PFP.

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## **Application for the Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)**

**Applications for the PFP will open in January 2024, on the day of the GCE Ordinary-Level (O-Level) Examinations results release**. Candidates eligible for the PFP will receive a copy of Form P on the same day, inviting them to apply for the PFP.

## **Pathways for 4NA**

### For students who are only interested in the <u>PFP</u>:

- You should first progress to Sec 5N(A), even if you meet the PFP eligibility criteria based on their GCE N(A)-Level results.
- You may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2024. If your application is successful, you will withdraw from Sec 5N(A) by the end of January 2024.
- All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till the last Friday of January 2023, i.e. **26 January 2024**.

### For students who are only interested in the <u>DPP</u>:

- You should apply for the **DPP**.
- Students who have accepted their DPP offers in December should not continue with Sec 5N(A). Please inform the school General Office and 4NA
   CCs so that we need not reserve a place for you in Sec 5 in 2024.





## What if I am interested in PFP and DPP?

#### For students who are interested in applying for <u>both PFP and DPP</u>:

- You are encouraged to consider carefully your interests and strengths, as well as the courses offered under both programmes.
- If you are certain that you do not want to continue with Sec 5 and pursue the GCE O-Level, you <u>SHOULD</u> apply for the DPP in December. Upon the release of the GCE O-Level results in January, eligible students may apply for the PFP. If you are offered and accept a PFP place, you can then withdraw from the DPP.

#### Alternatively;

• You may progress to Sec 5 first. Upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January, you may then apply for the **PFP and DPP concurrently**.



# **Pathways for 4NA**

### For students who are interested in applying for <u>Sec 5</u>

Sec 4N(A) students can be promoted to Sec 5N(A) if they satisfy **all** the following criteria:-

- (a) Sat for the GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2023;
- (a) Obtained an **ELMAB3** (EL, Mathematics (MA) and best three other subjects) aggregate score of **16 to 19 points**; and
- (b) Obtained at least an N(A)-Level Grade 5 for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3.

\*Subjects graded 'U' in the GCE N(A)-Level cannot be considered for the computation of the ELMAB3 aggregate score.

\*Please attend a zoom session with the Principal at <u>5pm on 19 Dec 2023</u>. Details will be shared by CCs.





# **Pathways for 4NT**

### • Progression from Sec 4N(T) to Sec 4N(A)

If you have achieved Grade A for <u>both</u> English Language (EL) and Mathematics (MA), and Grade B or better for <u>one</u> other subject at the N(T)-level in one sitting, you can be laterally transferred to Sec 4N(A).

### • Progression to ITE Nitec

Sec 4N(T) students with **0 or 1 N(T)-Level subject pass** can enrol in the enhanced Nitec Foundation Programme (e-NFP). The e-NFP aims to strengthen students' literacy and numeracy foundations, to help them successfully complete their Nitec courses.

- CCA Certificate
- 2024 ITE Admission Booklet

You should acknowledge on the class list the receipt of items 1-4.



## **Amendments Process – CCA Certificates**

Actions to take for <u>any amendment</u> to the <u>CCA Certificate</u>:

- STILL acknowledge the RECEIPT
- Clearly <u>indicate the error</u> and bring the <u>edited copy</u> to the <u>General</u> <u>Office</u> after release of results (4.00 pm onwards)
- GO staff will attend to you
- Ask for a <u>duplicate copy/copies</u> to facilitate your applications before you leave the GO



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## **Amendment Process – N Level Certificates**

- Only candidates who obtain at least grade 5 in one or more GCE N(A)-Level subjects will be awarded with a GCE N(A)-Level Examination Certificate.
   Similarly, candidates who obtain at least grade D in one or more GCE N(T)-Level subjects will be awarded with a GCE N(T)-Level Examination Certificate.
- Candidates may request for a re-print of their certificate only if their names were printed wrongly due to misspelling.
- Please still acknowledge the RECEIPT, clearly indicate the error and bring the edited copy to the General Office after release of results (4.00 pm onwards) and GO staff will attend to you. There is an administrative fee of <u>S\$50.00</u> (inclusive of GST) for the amendment of each GCE N-level certificate.



# **Appeal for Review of Results**

- Candidates of 2023 GCE N(A)/N(T)-Level examination may apply to appeal for a review of results.
- All appeals by candidates must be submitted through schools.
- Candidates can request for an 'Individual Appeal'. This comprises a review of the marking and a full clerical re-check.
- The candidate will be informed of the outcome via a letter.
- No report on the candidate's performance will be provided.
- The closing date for submission of appeals, including payment of appeal fees is by 22 December 2023. The payment for an individual appeal is \$112.35.
- Applications submitted after the closing date will not be considered.
