What do you need to prepare before the exercise?

- Log out of their Student iCon account from all personal devices (mobile phone, home PC etc).
- Bring along your student pass (EZ-link card with photo)
- Access to their Student iCon <u>user ID</u>

 and <u>password</u>



Other important information

Responsible Use of PLD

- No sharing of user ID and password.
- Do not tamper with the DMA. It must remain installed at all times. Update your PLD regularly or when prompted.
- Ensure it is fully charged and bring it to school daily.
- Do not leave your PLD unattended. Use your lockers.
