Attire:

- •Candidates should be in <u>half school uniform</u> and proper school shoes.
- •No slippers are allowed.

Handphones / Other electronic devices:

- •Candidates are strongly advised not to bring along their handphones and/or other electronic devices.

- Empty your pockets and show them to the invigilator, when requested by the Invigilator.

After Exam:

Movements of candidates

- Liaison Officers will be assisting candidates' movement from one venue to the other venue. *Eg. From labs to quarantine room.*
- Candidates will move together in an orderly manner.
- During the movement, candidates are not allowed to go elsewhere or engage in any form of communication with others who are not involved in the practical examination.

Food & Drinks

- Candidates in Shift 1 are strongly advised to bring their own <u>dry</u>
 <u>rations</u> for consumption.
 - All food are to be placed in a plastic bag and passed to the Liaison Officer for collection upon reporting.
 - A label will be given to you to tag your food.

Application for Special Consideratio n

You may apply for Special considerations, provided that:

- You have sat for at least 50% of the total assessment of the affected subject, and
- You have the relevant supporting documents to support your application (e.g. medical report/statement from a qualified medical practitioner) to certify that you are unfit for the examination.
